Together in Faith: But wanting to justify himself, the lawyer asked Jesus, “And who is my neighbor?” *Luke 10:29*

Unfortunately, the answer we often hear today is, “Our neighbor is the one like us.” The point of Jesus' story, of course, is exactly the opposite.
